SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- April 2024

KEY ACTIVITIES

STATUS

- **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: 38.91 million gallons were treated during April. The highest Daily flow was 1.68 million gallons on the 2nd and the lowest flow was 1.05 million gallons on the 23rd. The average flow was 1.30 million gallons. Total rainfall for April was 3.11 inches. 220 yards of biosolids were applied on site in.
- **WTP** Highest production day was 3,396,000 gallons on April 25, 2024.
- **Water System** Replaced 6 meters. Replaced 1 meter box. Repaired 1 water main.
- **Streets** Swept 140 curb miles with 16 cubic yards of material removed from the streets. 25 yards of gravel applied to gravel roads.
- **Parks** Parks Board: Total # of volunteers = 5, Total # of hours = 5; Planted 4 Cherry Trees and 4 Fir Trees at Pioneer Park.
