New Dog Control and Registration Procedures
by Stayton Police Chief Rich Sebens

The City of Stayton will no longer license your dog or respond to dog control issues. These services will be handled by Marion County Dog Control. They enforce the County Code for Aggressive behavior – Dangerous and potentially dangerous dog; Running at large; Nuisance dog violations - trespass, damaged property, barking; Stray dog pick-up; and Dog license violations.
