Stayton Public Library Offers Cultural Passes

Did you know the Stayton Public Library has passes to various local cultural destinations? Cultural Passes available at the Library can be borrowed and used toward free admission into several local museums and other fun places.



Currently, you can check-out passes to locations such as A.C. Gilbert Discovery Village; Willamette Heritage Center; Portland Japanese Garden; Evergreen Aviation and Space Museum; Portland Aquarium; Stayton Family Memorial Pool; Lan Su Chinese Garden; Crystal Springs Rhododendron Garden; and the Oregon Garden.

Cultural passes can be reserved at the circulation desk up to three months in advance and are checked out for two days. The passes are provided free and can only be checked-out by adult patrons who use Stayton Public Library as their home library.
