Fleishman led the City Council through a discussion of the proposed amendments to the Sign Code. He explained that there were three distinct issues under consideration and the discussion would flow best if the Council could stick to discussing one issue at a time without jumping between issues.

Nonconforming signs

Following discussion, the council agreed that the current requirement in the Code that nonconforming signs be removed in 2013 should be repealed. Changes to the amendment as proposed by the Planning Commission were agreed to keep portions of Section 17.20.140.6.c in the Code. The Council also agreed that Section 17.20.140.6.b.1) and 2) should be removed from the Code so that businesses do not need to remove nonconforming signs in order to receive a permit for a new sign.

Signs in the DRMU Zone

Following discussion, the council agreed that no change to the proposed ordinance is appropriate.

Sign Maintenance

Following discussion, the council agreed that owners of damaged signs should be given 45 days to repair the sign instead of 30 days, as previously proposed.
