SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- March 2021

KEY ACTIVITIES

STATUS

- **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: 51.24 million gallons were treated during March. The highest Daily flow was 2.26 million gallons on March 1st, and the lowest flow was 1.33 million gallons on the 28th. The average flow was 1.65 million gallons. Total rainfall for March was 2.77 inches. 2 yards of Santiam Green biosolids were hauled off site in March.
- **WTP** Highest production day was 2,520,000 gallons on March 5th.
- **Water System** Replaced 16 water meters. Water line repair to 1" galvanized steel line behind Stayton Municipal Court, abandoned broken ¾" galvanized steel service line on Florence Ave, and replaced meter stop at 1189 5th Ave.
- **Streets** Swept 10 curb miles and 2 cubic yards of material was collected. Assisted with clean up after ice storm.
- **Parks** None for March 2021.
- **Building Permits**
