



Stayton Family Memorial Pool Patron Protocols and Waiver

Maximum of 20 Patrons Allowed in Facility Due to COVID-19 Restrictions

1. Patrons are to follow all pool rules of this facility as outlined and enforced by Stayton Family Memorial Pool staff. All patrons need to be courteous to other patrons and Pool staff. Always be respectful of staff in their enforcement of all rules.
2. Patrons showing symptoms of COVID-19 or other sickness (including but not limited to fever, cough, or shortness of breath) will not be admitted to the Pool facility and are encouraged to stay home.
3. Prior to coming to the Pool facility, all patrons must sign up for lap swim/fitness classes/open swims through their membership portal ([Online Patron Portal](#)). Patrons are encouraged to sign-up for only **one** lap swim/fitness class/open swim per day, but may ask non-lifeguarding staff if space is available in the next class and if available, pay for additional time. This will be allowed on a first come, first serve basis.
4. All lap swim/fitness classes will be 55 minutes in length. This allotted time includes time for patrons to enter and exit the facility and allows staff time to sanitize prior to the next scheduled class.
5. Patrons will be allowed to enter the Pool facility no more than 5 minutes before their scheduled time. Patrons will enter the pool area through the front lobby and must scan-in or check-in/pay at the front counter. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, non-paying person(s) will not be allowed in the facility. Upon arrival, patrons will be assigned a designated poolside location to place their personal belongings while in the facility.
6. Patrons are required to wear a mask in the facility at all times except while in the water. Patron may leave their mask in their designated poolside location on deck (use of a plastic bag to keep dry is suggested). A patron may choose to wear their mask while in the water but must stay in the shallow end of the pool and keep head above the water at all times.
7. Locker rooms are closed. Patrons must come dressed to enter the water and leave directly after class time. Patrons must keep all belongings in assigned deck area location. Only patrons living in the same household may share a space. Patrons may use the locker rooms to access the restrooms only. An on-deck shower will be available to rinse off. Aquatic staff will turn the shower on before the end of or start of classes. Patrons must exit the pool area only through the rear or side doors, whichever is closer to your designated location on deck.
8. Patrons must maintain a 6 foot distance from anyone not in their household. Parent/legal guardian will be responsible for making sure all child(ren) practice good social distancing while in the facility and must be in the water with them.
9. All patrons are encouraged to bring their own pool equipment. All Stayton Family Memorial Pool pool equipment will be distributed and picked-up by staff only. All equipment will be disinfected after use. Parents/guardians are requested to bring child(ren)s own Coast Guard approved life jacket.
10. The water fountain will be for water bottle filling only; patrons are encouraged to bring their own water bottle.
11. Rope swing, slide and basketball hoop will remain closed at this time due to disinfecting issues.
12. Patrons unable to follow posted rules will be asked to leave the facility.

By signing this agreement, I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that my family, including child(ren), and I may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 while on site at the pool and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at the pool may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, the City of Stayton and Stayton Family Memorial Pool management, employees, volunteers, and program participants and their families. I voluntarily agree to assume all of the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to my child(ren) or myself (including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, and death), illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind, that I, my family and my child(ren) may experience or incur in connection with my child(ren)'s attendance at the pool or participation in pool activities ("Claims"). On my behalf, and on behalf of my children, I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless the City of Stayton and Stayton Family Memorial Pool management and their employees, agents, and representatives, of and from the Claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto. I understand and agree that this release includes any Claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of the City of Stayton and Stayton Family Memorial Pool management and their employees, agents, and representatives, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation in pool facility activities.
