KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

• WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 34.18 million gallons were treated during June. The highest Daily

flow was 1.64 million gallons on the 3rd and the lowest flow was 0.93 million gallons on the 30th. The average flow was 1.14 million gallons. Total rainfall for

June was 1.62 inches. No bio solids were hauled off site.

WTP Highest production day was 4,015,000 gallons on June 25, 2024.

Water System Replaced 12 meters. Replaced 1 meter box. Repaired 2 water service lines.

• Streets Swept 90 curb miles with 15 cubic yards of material removed from the streets. 4

yards of gravel applied to gravel roads. 4,734 gallons of dust control applied to

gravel roads.
