KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

• WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 48.59 million gallons were treated during May. The highest Daily

flow was 2.87 million gallons on the 5th and the lowest flow was 1.03 million gallons on the 30th. The average flow was 1.57 million gallons. Total rainfall was

4.13 inches. No bio solids were hauled off site.

WTP Highest production day was 3,781,000 gallons on May 14, 2024.

• Water System Replaced 7 meters. Replaced 1 meter box. Repaired 1 meter stop.

• Streets Swept 110 curb miles with 17 cubic yards of material removed from the streets.

2 yards of gravel applied to gravel roads.
