In August, over one hundred people joined us for Colombian-born songwriter and performer Nathalia, who painted a world of musical colors by fusing popular styles with traditional Latin American sounds and rhythms. Jennifer and Janna provided free books and activities at NSSD's Stayton Middle School Meal Site. We had our last Green STEAM program, and participants explored the world of native plants and pollinators. Thank you to Yarnell Nursery for loaning us the plants! We wrapped up a record-breaking Summer Reading with 149 people joining us for our End Celebration. Participants created bead mosaic frames, wall art from recycled materials, upcycled cd spinners, bowled with the world and enjoyed a sweet summer treat. Thank you to Korin, Denise, Even, Pam, Erika and Christian for volunteering at our event! We also had our Fiber Arts Connection program, and the adult book club met with Stephanie to discuss *The Magnificent Lives Of Marjorie Post* by Allison Pataki.

We had a successful first year of Safety Town, a weeklong, half-day summer camp for children ages five and six that we developed and ran in collaboration with the Stayton Police Department. Campers engaged in experiences around different safety topics with presentations, demonstrations, music, movement, STEAM activities, and by visiting the Safety Town traffic course and 911 practice lab daily. Thank you to our amazing teen volunteers who led each group of campers and to the Library, City, and Police Department staff and volunteers who made Safety Town possible!
