SUBJECT: July Library report

In July, seventy-four children and family members joined Jennifer, Shelby, Janna, Kim and Evie as we explored water samples under microscopes, made water filters, explored how watersheds work, "spray" painted with water and ran water relays at our Green STEAM Water Works program. We want to give a special shout-out to Monique from Public Works for her display. Jennifer, Kim, Nicole and Shelby had great crowds for Storytime in Community Center Park. Seventy people of all ages came for Sew Renewable and explored different types of creative mending to give new life to clothes otherwise headed for the trash. Thank you to April, Korin and Denise, who volunteered their sewing and ironing skills to help make the program possible!

We hosted the Paradise of Samoa Polynesian Dance Troupe, and ninety-nine people of all ages enjoyed their tour of the Pacific Islands through dance, traditional costumes, and narration. Eighty-one children and family members joined us for Jeff Evan's interactive magic and comedy show, and sixty-one people joined us as we hosted Alseny Yansane with the West African Cultural Arts Institute; he shared the joy and passion of Guinean culture with music and dance.

Jennifer, Janna, and Stephanie provided free books and activities on Mondays at NSSD's Stayton Middle School Meal Site. At our DIY Craftshop program, people of all ages created upcycled wall art. Stephanie hosted a craft swap and a crafting competition. Janna, Jennifer, and Shelby ran the Library booth at Summerfest.
