SUBJECT: May Library report

In May, sixty children and family members joined Jennifer, Kim, Shelby, Stephanie, Nicole, and our puppet crew for an Endangered Species Puppet Show. Afterwards, the children made puppets to take home. We opened our STEAM Lab for an hour after school every afternoon for a week, and children of all ages unleashed their inner builders with our LEGOs.

Family Storytime and Toddler Time finished up for the season. Jennifer and Evie opened the Readers Café, and twenty-five people stopped in to "taste" some new children's titles, explore new book options, and take home a book of their choice to keep. People of all ages made yarn birds with Stephanie and Janna at our DIY Craftshop and book club met with Stephanie to discuss *The Patron Saint of Second Chances* by Christine Simon.

Jennifer provided Storytime at Stayton Elementary School's Kindergarten Roundup, and Janna provided program support. Jennifer represented Stayton at the PYM Children's Services, and Janna ran the CCRLS Polk, Yamhill and Marion County (PYM) Library Directors at the Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde Tribal Library.
